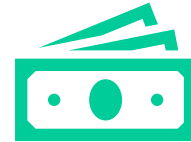

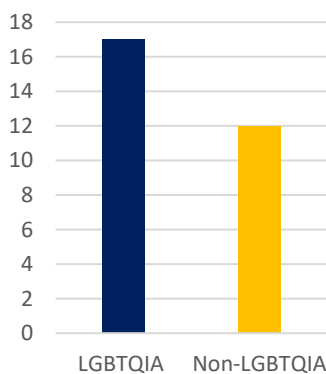

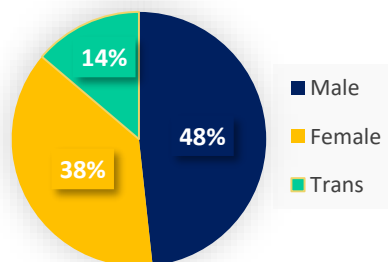

Gender & Sexual Orientation

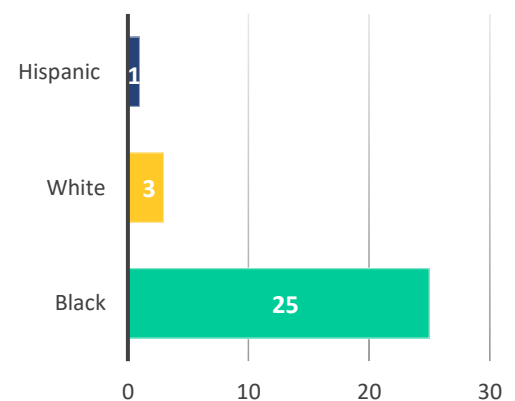


Trans and Non-Binary = 4
